

NEW PUBLICATION

In March 2008, the Gloucester Historical Society (GHS) published its latest book, entitled **Pioneer Families of Rockcliffe Annex and Manor Park in Gloucester Township**. This 36-page book contains a first chapter on the precise geographical location of the community, its two designations and its close neighbours. A second chapter describes the historical background, and a third, longer chapter provides detailed biographical and genealogical information about 34 pioneer families who lived in Manor Park between 1915 and 1948.

The author, Robert Serré, has lived in Manor Park since June 1978. A retired translator, Robert has been focussing on the history of Gloucester Township since 2004. Having recently published books on the pioneer families of New Edinburgh and Hurdman's Bridge, he is preparing another book on Janeville, later called Eastview.
