In September 2007, the Gloucester Historical Society (GHS) published its latest book, entitled **Pioneer Families of Hurdman's Bridge (Gloucester Township)**. This 46-page book contains a brief history of the village of Hurdman's Bridge, as well as biographical and genealogical profiles of 55 pioneer families.

The author, Robert Serré, grew up in Ottawa's Sandy Hill neighbourhood, and now lives in Manor Park. A retired translator, Robert has become an avid local historian. Having recently published books on the pioneer families of the Gloucester Quarries, Glen Ogilvie, Cyrville and New Edinburgh, he is preparing another book on Janeville.
